- (i) in relation to PR Notes issued by (a) NAB or (b) BNZ, a supplement to the Offering Circular for the purposes of Article 23(1) of the Prospectus Regulation and has been approved as such by the *Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier* (the **CSSF**) as competent authority under the Prospectus Regulation; and
- (ii) in relation to Exempt Notes issued by (a) NAB or (b) BNZ, a supplement to the Offering Circular for the purposes of rule 206 of Part 2, Chapter 2 of the rules and regulations of the Luxembourg Stock Exchange and has been approved as such by the Luxembourg Stock Exchange as competent entity under Part IV of the Prospectus Act 2019.

This Supplement is prepared in connection with the Programme established by, *inter alios*, NAB and BNZ. Capitalised terms used but not otherwise defined in this Supplement shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Offering Circular. When used in this Supplement, **Prospectus Regulation** means Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 and **Prospectus Act 2019** means the Luxembourg act dated 16 July 2019 on prospectuses for securities.

This Supplement constitutes a supplement to, and should be read in conjunction with, the Offering Circular and all documents which are deemed to be incorporated therein by reference (see "*Documents Incorporated by Reference and Credit Ratings—(A) Documents Incorporated by Reference*" in the Offering Circular, as amended hereby).

NAB and BNZ accept responsibility for the information contained in this Supplement, other than in the case of the information contained in (i) section 1 of this Supplement (including the document incorporated by reference in accordance with section 3 of this Supplement), in respect of which, NAB accepts responsibility and (ii) section 2 of this Supplement (including the document incorporated by reference in accordance with section 3 of this Supplement), in respect of which, BNZ accepts responsibility. ## 1. NAB 2023 FIRST QUARTER TRADING UPDATE

## 2. CONSTITUTION OF BNZ

On 3 February 2023, the sole shareholder of BNZ passed a special written resolution revoking the existing BNZ constitution and adopting the new BNZ constitution (the **New BNZ Constitution**). The New BNZ Constitution was adopted by BNZ with effect from 3 February 2023.

A copy of the New BNZ Constitution has been filed with the CSSF and the Luxembourg Stock Exchange and, by virtue of this Supplement, the New BNZ Constitution is incorporated by reference into, and forms part of, the Offering Circular, to the extent provided in section 3 of this Supplement below, and is available via <https://dl.bourse.lu/dlp/1019723c2f599244618e2812cd38e39bb6>. The previous constitution of BNZ is no longer considered by BNZ to be relevant for investors.

The list of documents incorporated by reference on pages 87 to 91 (inclusive) of the Offering Circular (under the section headed, “*Documents Incorporated by Reference and Credit Ratings—(A) Documents Incorporated by Reference*”) shall be construed accordingly and, by virtue of this Supplement, item “(d)” on page 90 of the Offering Circular in relation to the constitution of BNZ, shall be amended as follows:

- (i) the existing references in item “(d)” on page 90 of the Offering Circular to the “constitution of BNZ” shall be deemed to be references to the “previous constitution of BNZ”; and
- (ii) item “(d)” on page 90 of the Offering Circular shall be deemed to include a reference to the pages of the New BNZ Constitution (available via
